A) Mid Term Exam Procedures + Rules Middle/High School

- 1. Student must be in his/her classroom 15 minutes before the exam starts (Middle school 07:45 and High school 09:15)
- 2. Do not be late and be well prepared
- 3. Student must be seated in his/her assigned classroom: no talking, whispering, turning around, leaving the classroom...exam must be completed in one seat.
- 4. Student is not allowed to use corrector, pencil, color, and erasable pens, only blue or black pen.
- 5. Each exam has a specific amount of time (1 hour) allotted.
- 6. The exam must be submitted within the time allotted before the time expires.
- 7. Student must write his/her full name on the Exam paper; exam without the student's full name is cancelled.
- 8. Student is not allowed to ask permission to go outside during the exam time.
- 9. Student is not allowed to leave the classroom before 45 minutes after the start of the examination.

10. No student can enter the school after the exam starts. NO EXCEPTIONS!

B) Prohibited actions + behavior

- 1. Copying the exam questions or answers
- 2. Bringing mobile devices/smart phones, laptops or other devices during the exam
- 3. Borrowing pens and calculators
- 4. Cheat notes, mobile phones, Air Pods, smart-watches, or any other unfair means is strictly prohibited

C) Penalties

Breaking any of the above-mentioned rules will cause the students removal from the classroom and cancellation of the exam/grades.
